

# Bonar Creek Stormwater Management Facility and Extension of Legion Road

## Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Completion

The City of Toronto has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to implement a stormwater management facility and review alternatives for extending Legion Rd. in the vicinity of Bonar Creek. The Bonar Creek Stormwater Management Facility was identified in the 25-year implementation plan for the Wet Weather Flow Master Plan (WWFMP) to improve stormwater quality in Mimico Creek. The extension of Legion Rd. was identified in the City's Official Plan to provide an alternate access to, and from, Lake Shore Blvd. W. for existing and proposed development north of the CN Rail corridor, west of Mimico Creek. This study defines the problem, identifies and evaluates alternative solutions, and determines a preferred solution in consultation with the City of Toronto, regulatory agencies, and the public.

The City has accepted the consultant's recommendations for:

- Construction of a stormwater management facility (wet pond) adjacent to Mimico Creek.
- Extension of Legion Rd. from its current northern limit to the Park Lawn Rd. exit ramp from the east bound F.G. Gardiner Expressway using a single portal tunnel under the CN rail corridor.

### Opportunities for Review

The study was carried out following the requirements for Schedule 'C' projects under the Municipal Class EA. An Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been placed on public record for a 30-day review period starting July 29, 2010 and ending August 30, 2010. It will be available for review at:
