THE ROUTE OF HEROES

The City of Toronto, in conjunction with the Royal Canadian Legion, has introduced the Route of Heroes - a ceremonial route along the Don Valley Parkway and city streets directly to the Coroner's Office - in honour of Canada's fallen soldiers.

The Route of Heroes continues the route taken by Canadian soldiers as they travel from CFB Trenton along Highway 401, the "Highway of Heroes", and into Toronto on their final journey. The Route will be marked as follows: Starting south of Highway 401, along the Don Valley Parkway to the Bloor/Bayview exit at ramp to Bloor Street East, then westbound on Bloor Street to Bay Street and south on Bay Street to the Coroner's Office on Grenville Street. Signs will be placed at the intersections of major arterial roads along the route.

ROAD CLOSURES

Gardiner Expressway closed overnight this weekend for construction work

The City of Toronto is continuing its construction activities at the Jameson Avenue Bridge over the Gardiner Expressway. To perform this work safely, overnight closures will be required for the Gardiner Expressway between the Don Valley Parkway and the Humber River from Sunday, June 13 to early Monday, June 14.

- The eastbound lanes of the expressway will be closed from Sunday, June 13 at 8 p.m. to Monday, June 14 at 1 a.m.

- The westbound lanes of the expressway will be closed from Sunday, June 13 at 9 p.m. to Monday, June 14 at 5 a.m.

This closure is necessary to reinstate three lanes of traffic on the Gardiner Expressway at the ongoing bridge rehabilitation work in the Jameson Avenue.

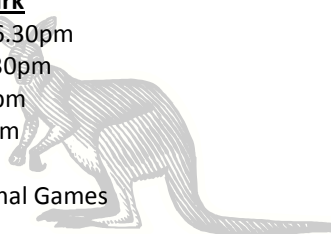

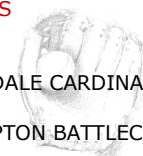
